

CAMP MESA DO's and DON'Ts

IF YOU HEAR EMERGENCY SIRENS, IMMEDIATELY PROCEED TO THE MESA CAFETERIA (G-50) UNLESS DIRECTED OTHERWISE BY AN AUTHORIZED EDISON REPRESENTATIVE.

- DO...**
- get registered and approved for resident camping with an Authorized Edison Representative.
 - sign a release of liability form, all adult resident campers, prior to residing at any Camp Mesa facility.
 - supervise children under the age of 18 at all times.
 - ensure guests are not in the campground between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. daily.
 - diligently remove all pet droppings; silence or remove barking dogs; keep dogs on a leash at all times when outside an RV.
 - keep noises to a minimum 24 hours a day to be considerate of other resident campers working swing/night shifts.
 - maintain your site in a clean, neat and attractive condition.
 - secure your valuables. SCE is not responsible for lost or stolen property or for any damage to any vehicle during your stay.
 - barbeque in approved containers.
 - extinguish all smoking materials after use.
 - contain open fires within provided fire rings; if you don't have one, request one.
 - obtain your own firewood; firewood is NOT a company provided item and may not be obtained from company property under any circumstances.
 - dispose of trash in provided receptacles.
 - obey the posted speed limit of 10mph in all camping areas.
 - use approved tank chemical - Aqua-chem.
 - deposit outgoing US mail in the box located outside W-44.
 - seek means to receive incoming mail at your own expense. You are encouraged to purchase a PO Box at the local post office or at a local Mail Boxes, Etc.

- DO NOT...**
- wash or perform maintenance on vehicles.
 - allow the discharge of motor coolant, oil, fuel or sewage material of any type to the environment.
 - hang clothes lines outside your vehicle(s).
 - sleep in vehicles not designed for sleeping, this is prohibited at SONGS.
 - possess or set off fireworks on the premises.

SONGS / SCE Management reserves the right to search any vehicle for cause.

Failure to abide by the aforementioned guidelines will result in your dismissal from the campground facility, as well as denial of future campground privileges and/or employment opportunities at SONGS.

GENERAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY
Request to Use The Camp Mesa RV Campground
at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS)
and General Release of Liability

1. I request from Southern California Edison Company ("Edison") the right to reside at the Camp Mesa RV Campground ("Camp Mesa") at SONGS Mesa while I am working at SONGS during the outages of Units 2 and 3 ("Outages"). In consideration for Edison's allowing me and my family members to reside at Camp Mesa, I agree to abide by, and ensure that my family members abide by, the official rules and guidelines governing the use of Camp Mesa, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

2. I understand and acknowledge that SONGS is located on property owned by the federal government ("Camp Pendleton"), which is otherwise used as a military base for training and other military purposes. I also understand and acknowledge that mountain lions and other wild animals are natural inhabitants of Camp Pendleton and that such mountain lions and other wild animals have been sighted on SONGS property, including the Mesa.

3. I acknowledge that residing on a military base can be hazardous to personal safety and can cause damage to property and that wild animals can also cause personal injuries and property damage. Nevertheless, I have made a voluntary choice to reside at Camp Mesa, despite such attendant risks. In consideration for Edison permitting me and my family members to reside at Camp Mesa free of charge, I knowingly accept and acknowledge full responsibility for my safety and the safety of my family members who reside with me at Camp Mesa, as well as any guest who may visit me at Camp Mesa, and assume any and all known and unknown risks of personal injury or property damage, which may be associated with or result from my/our residence at Camp Mesa, including but not limited to risks which may arise from: (i) military activities at Camp Pendleton; or (ii) wild animals that may enter upon SONGS property, including Camp Mesa.

4. I understand and acknowledge that residing at Camp Mesa is a privilege and benefit offered by Edison as a free accommodation to workers during the Outages. I acknowledge that any non-work-related activity in which I participate while residing at Camp Mesa will be considered an off-duty recreational and/or athletic activity, which is not part of my regular work duties and that Edison **SHALL NOT** be liable for payment of any Worker's Compensation benefits for any injury that may occur during such work activities or use of the facilities at Camp Mesa.

5. I understand and acknowledge that, during the time that I reside at Camp Mesa, neither Edison nor its directors, officers, agents, or employees **SHALL** have any responsibility to provide me or my family or guests with any extraordinary security protection against any known or unknown dangers existing on or about Camp Pendleton, SONGS, the Mesa, or Camp Mesa, beyond the general security protection offered to the general public while visiting such areas.

6. I further release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Edison, its officers, agents, or employees for liability for personal injury to me, or any person claiming an interest through me, whether caused by their negligence or for any other reason, while residing at Camp Mesa.

7. I further indemnify and hold Edison, its directors, officers, agents, and employees harmless from all loss, liability, damage, or claim resulting from my presence at or actions while residing at Camp Mesa or otherwise on Edison property, whether caused in part by their negligence or otherwise.

8. I intend that this General Release be as broad as the law permits, and that, if any portion is deemed to be invalid, the remainder **SHALL** continue in full force and effect. This release is entered into solely for the benefit of Edison, its directors, officers, agents, and employees, when engaged in activities which promote the business interests of Edison, and does not confer a release upon persons not acting in such capacity.

9. I understand and acknowledge that this release applies to personal injury or property damage of all persons, including dependent minors, who will reside with or visit me at Camp Mesa and that each such adult person will be required to read, understand, and acknowledge an equivalent General Release for Edison's benefit, before being allowed to reside with or visit me on Edison property.

10. SCE is not responsible for supplying portable cords/adapters that supply power between pedestal mounts and recreational vehicles, nor is SCE responsible for any damage to recreational vehicles as a result of using such cords/adapters.

I, the undersigned, have read and understand this release and all of its terms, and warrant that the above is true and correct in all respects and that no representations, statements, or inducements apart from the foregoing have been made by Edison, its directors, officers, agents, or employees to encourage me to reside at Camp Mesa.

GENERAL UNDERSTANDING OF POLICY GUIDELINE SIGN-OFF

I have read policy guideline SSSPG-SO123-G-3 in its entirety. I understand what my responsibilities are, as briefly outlined below, **should** I be approved for residency at Camp Mesa.

1. I will report to the **Campground Resident Assembly Area, G-50 Mesa Cafeteria, should I** hear alert sirens, in the event of an emergency, unless directed otherwise.
2. I will advise the Campground Administrator **should** additional members of my family or another employee begin residing at the campground with me, to ensure the General Release of Liability form is filled out for said additional adult outage resident(s) (18 years and older).
3. I understand and will abide by the alcohol rules as stated in the Camp Mesa Guideline (SSSPG-SO123-G-3) and the Fitness for Duty Nuclear Directive (D-006).
4. I understand and will abide by the firearm(s) rule as stated in the Camp Mesa Guideline (SSSPG-SO123-G-3) and the Searches Nuclear Directive (D-028).
5. I will ensure that my children (if applicable) remain within the identified perimeter of the campground and are supervised by a responsible individual at all times.
6. I will ensure that my pets (if applicable) remain within the identified perimeter, are on a leash, and are kept quiet, and I will diligently remove all pet droppings.
7. I will observe the posted speed limit within the campground.
8. I will keep noises to a minimum 24 hours a day to be considerate of other outage residents working different shifts.
9. I will maintain my site in a clean, neat, and attractive condition.
10. I will remove all trash, compressed gas cylinders, Hazardous, Universal Waste material and items brought in and leave the site as found upon my departure.
11. I will NOT wash or perform maintenance on my vehicle(s) within the campground.
12. I will seek means for which to send and receive mail at my own expense, and will not have mail or package delivered to SONGS.
13. I am aware that I may be dismissed without prior notice for failure to abide by established site policies, procedures, Nuclear Directives, and/or guidelines.
14. I understand that I may be denied future campground privileges and/or employment opportunities at SONGS for not following the direction stated within this guideline.
15. I understand and will abide by the outage parking plan which indicates that I must ride the shuttle bus to and from the plant side. I will not drive my personal vehicle to and from work.



Policy on Portable Head Set and Cell Phone Use

All site personnel are required to follow the expectations regarding use of Portable Head Sets (i.e. iPODs) and Cell Phones outlined below. If you observe personnel using these devices in an unsafe manner, coach the worker and report the observation to supervision.

- Under no circumstances are Portable Head Sets approved as a substitute for proper hearing protection. Only station approved hearing protection shall be used (ref. SO123-XVI-7).
- Use of a Portable Head Set (i.e., iPOD, MP3 player) is prohibited while walking anywhere on site. It is critical to be able to hear all the various alarms, PA addresses, and other audible plant information while on site.
- Hand held cell phone use is prohibited while walking anywhere on site. If cell phone use is necessary, stop and find a safe area.
- Keep Eyes (and Ears) on Path at all times.
